Cradled within the arms of the Ubombo mountains to the west and the Indian Ocean to the east, Phinda is situated in Zululand, within one of Africa's most ecologically diverse regions with an extraordinary range of ecosystems and wildlife. Within Phinda's 15 000 hectares, seven distinct ecosystems are to be found - from palm savanna and mountain bushveld, to rare sand forest and dense thornveld - each with its own typical flora and fauna. And in one of the continent's boldest reintroduction programs, elephant, white rhino, lion and cheetah have been resettled at Phinda where they now roam alongside leopard, nyala, giraffe and a host of other antelope. The over 350 bird species will take your breath away in their rainbow plumages - as will the richness of other animal, insect, reptile, plant and marine life.

Day 6

Today you will be collected from the hotel at 08h30 for a full day tour of Cape Peninsula including the Cape Point Nature Reserve and Boulders Beach to view the Penguins. Before heading out to Cape Point, a cableway journey up Table Mountain (weather permitting) is included

The great charm of Cape Town is the magnificent mountain. It rises behind the city and is a sheer precipice to a height of 1 097m (3.566ft) cutting the skyline with a horizontal front three kilometres (almost two miles) in length. The best views are from the top of Table Mountain. The cableway takes you to the summit in under ten minutes whilst rotating gondola's ensure visitors enjoy a 360 view of the city.

Breathtaking scenery ignites the senses where the chilly waters of the Atlantic in the west meet the warm waters of False Bay in the east. Take the funicular to the old lighthouse overlooking this wild coast. The peninsula divides at the tip into three points, the Cape of Good Hope, Cape Maclear, and Cape Point. The Cape of Good Hope section of the Cape Peninsula National Park's flora is something to behold, with its fynbos species found nowhere else in the world. Stop at Boulders Beach, to see the penguins. Travel through Simon's Town and Fish Hoek, along Boyes Drive, which offers glorious views of the False Bay coastline, and the Hottentots Holland Mountains.



Day 7

This morning you will be collected from the hotel at 09h15 for a full day tour of the Cape Winelands including two wine tastes and a visit to the Stellenbosch Museum or the Franschhoek Museum. Lunch included at La Petite Ferme Restaurant, in Franschhoek
